COVID-19 LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease.

Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life- threatening illness and even death.

The National Association of Judiciary Interpreters and Translators (NAJIT), its officers, directors, management company, and volunteers cannot prevent you from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID19 while attending the NAJIT conferences and/or entering onto premises where NAJIT events are held. Therefore, if you choose to attend an event organized by NAJIT and enter onto premises where its conferences are held, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claim based in negligence, including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.
