

The NAJIT Observer Guidelines for Authors

Thank you for expressing your interest in contributing to The NAJIT Observer!

This platform offers members, colleagues, and guests a space to share insights, firsthand experiences, and stories with others in the field. We aim to make the blogging process enjoyable, and with that goal in mind, we've outlined these simple guidelines to help you get started.

Length

Posts should be concise, ideally ranging between 600–800 words. While 1,000 words is the maximum allowed, we encourage keeping within the 600-800-word range whenever possible.

- The document should be in 12-point Times New Roman font, double-spaced.
- The title of the blog post should be **centered**, followed by the author's name.
- Text in languages other than English should be italicized, with translations provided in square brackets following the text: Example: *Me llamo Juan*. [My name is Juan.]

Introductory Sentences

When a new blog is published, members receive an email featuring the opening paragraphs. To capture their interest, please start your blog with a brief overview or description that *highlights* the topic and invites readers to continue. This approach helps members quickly understand what the blog covers and encourages them to engage.

Example:

"Interpreting in legal settings demands precision and cultural awareness. In this post, we'll explore strategies for handling nuanced situations, share insights from seasoned interpreters, and discuss best practices to improve accuracy in high-stakes environments."

This opening sets the stage, clarifying the blog's focus while grabbing readers attention.



Search Engine Optimization (SEO)

Search engine optimization (SEO) involves tailoring a website or blog to appear more prominently in relevant search results. For blog posts, crafting clear, descriptive titles and subtitles is key.

Our TNO editor will handle the final titles and subtitles, though you're welcome to suggest one. Here are a few tips if you'd like to contribute a title:

- Titles should be at least four words long and include keywords found in the blog's content
- Subtitles are also beneficial and should incorporate keywords from the text.
- Begin your post with a brief content description. This helps draw in readers and enhances SEO by providing context right away.

Style

Write your post in a style that reflects your unique personality and voice. Ensure that your ideas are fully developed and flow in a clear, logical sequence.

Images (Artwork)

Typically, posts feature two images, one at the top and another within the body of the blog. While the TNO editor selects the final images, authors are welcome to submit their own, as long as they are not copyrighted. The editor ensures that any image aligns with the author's intent and reserves the right to make final content and image choices. It is also the editor's responsibility to confirm that NAJIT has the appropriate permissions to use each graphic, whether it's from a free source, includes credit to the creator, or has a

purchased license.

Engaging Readers

Since TNO serves as a platform for sharing ideas and resources, we recommend ending your blog with an invitation for readers to share their thoughts in the comments section. If your topic covers general knowledge, make it stand out by adding a unique, surprising, or



personal perspective. Aim to spark a reaction—take a stance, express an opinion, or share a relatable viewpoint that encourages readers to engage, discuss, and reflect.

These examples should make the topic relatable and actionable for readers.]

In addition to quotes, consider including a case study. Describe a situation faced by a professional or organization, the challenges encountered, the solutions applied, and the results achieved. This type of detailed example adds credibility to the insights and gives readers a template they can adapt to their own needs.

[Placeholder Section Title: Best Practices for Success]

[Placeholder text: Provide a few best practices or strategies related to the topic. Start with a brief introduction on why best practices are important and how they can enhance one's work. Then present the strategies in a structured format:

To foster further engagement, consider adding a question that directly prompts readers to think critically about the topic: "Which of these strategies do you think would be most effective in your work environment, and why?" This type of question encourages thoughtful responses and helps build a sense of community among readers.
